

#### How does RSS work?

All you need is an Internet connection and a RSS feed reader. This is a program that waits for your favorite sites to post new content. When something new pops up on a site you're subscribed to, it gets sent to your RSS reader instantaneously. Once you've installed an RSS feed reader, you can get started. You can even configure Outlook as an RSS reader!

# How do I use RSS on the GOOD website?

Once your RSS reader is installed, visit the GOOD website pages with RSS feed icons (Events, Jobs, Announcements). Click on the icon and copy to link. Paste the link into your RSS Reader.

Now every time the **Events** page, **Jobs** page, **Announcements** or other pages with the RSS icon are updated, your RSS reader will show the updates!
